**Rotation on the Succession to the Presidency of the
New Mexico High School Coaches Association**

The following motion was passed for the rotation on the succession to the presidency of the NMHSCA by the Board of Directors on July 27, 1998.

- A President Elect / Vice President shall be elected annually by the membership of the Association at the Annual Meeting. To be eligible for the office of President Elect / Vice President, a member must have served at least one year on the Board of Directors and be employed as an athletic coach.
- Beginning in **1999** the nomination and election of the President Elect / Vice President shall rotate between the five regions in the following order; **Northeast, Southeast, Northwest, Central, Southwest**. The person having served the longest tenure on the Board of Directors, from the respective region, shall be given first consideration for nomination to the office of President Elect / Vice President.
- Should a region not have an eligible candidate for the office of President Elect / Vice President the rotation shall move forward to the next region. The following year the rotation shall go back to the region that was bypassed for a nominee for the office. Following that year the rotation for a nominee shall revert back to the original set order between the regions.

Example: The NE does not have an eligible candidate, the rotation moves forward to the SE. The following year the rotation goes back to the NE then forward to the NW, in the original set order.

The following is the rotation for the next ten years:
